    - a. Four year high school graduation rate 95% by 2015
    - b. College ready rate 86% by 2015
    - c. Drill-down data for these indicators will include individual districts’ data, as requested by the Board on June 8th
    - d. Drill-down in the College Readiness indicator will include additional data on college enrollment and persistence
